Mayor Hasch opened the public hearing.

Amber Farha stated the budget included a half mill decrease. Cuts include 10% in operating expenses, equipment reserve transfers, and health insurance. Employees can expect no cost of living increase or annual step increases next year. This will leave us with a guaranteed \$409,000.00 reserve.

Representatives of the senior citizen center thanked the commission for the increased allocation to the center of \$10,000.00, over the \$4,000.00 given for the last several years.

2017 BUDGET APPROVAL


APPROVED
