

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-3138

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF A PUBLIC STREET AND SIDEWALK AND FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL AT A SPECIAL EVENT WITHIN THE CITY OF CONCORDIA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the City of Concordia, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That part of Broadway Street adjoining Lot One in Block One Hundred Thirty-Five (135) in the City of Concordia, Kansas, also described as Broadway Street from 6th Street to 7th Street in Block 135, and the public sidewalk on the west side of Broadway Street adjoining that lot, and that part of 6th Street between adjoining Lots One through Eighteen in Block One Hundred Thirty-Five (135) and Lots Nineteen through Thirty-Six in Block One Hundred Forty-Eight (148) in the City of Concordia, Kansas, also described as 6th Street from Broadway Street to Washington Street, and the public sidewalks on the north and south sides of 6th Street adjoining those lots, shall be closed to vehicular traffic with suitable barricades from 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. on September 22, 2018, for a special event consisting of a community celebration coordinated by the Concordia Fall Fest Committee and Concordia Chamber of Commerce, during which time access to the closed portion of Broadway and 6th Streets and the adjacent sidewalks shall be controlled by the Concordia Fall Fest Committee and Concordia Chamber of Commerce.

SECTION 2. Alcoholic beverages shall be permitted to be sold and consumed within the closed areas of Broadway Street, 6th Street and the adjoining sidewalks on the west side of Broadway Street and north and south sides of 6th Street from 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. on September 22, 2018.

SECTION 3. The boundaries of the area described above shall be clearly marked by temporary barricades during the time permitted for consumption and sale of alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 4. No alcoholic liquor may be consumed inside vehicles while on the closed portions of Broadway Street or 6th Street during the special event as described in Section 1.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be summarized for publication as follows:

On June 6, 2018, the City of Concordia adopted Ordinance No. 2018-3138, providing that Broadway Street from 6th Street to 7th Street, and 6th Street from Broadway Street to Washington Street, and the adjacent public sidewalks, shall be closed to vehicular traffic for a special event, and providing that alcoholic beverages shall be permitted to be sold and consumed within the closed areas of said streets and the adjoining sidewalks from 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. on September 22, 2018. SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication of the above ordinance summary. The provisions hereof are severable, and in the event of invalidity, for any reason, of any portion of this ordinance, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, with the invalid provisions deemed excised.
